## Introduction:

araswati Vidya Mandir Situated at Phulwaria, Azamgarh, is a branch of Saraswati Shishu Mandir Sr. Sec. School at Gorakhpur, a recognized senior secondary school. It is **Run by Swami Vivekanand Adarsh Shiksha Samiti.** The aim of the school is to nourish and nurture young spirited, spiritually awakened noble citizens who have strong heart and mind to dedicate themselves for national cause.

Saraswati Shishu Mandir was established in 1952 at Pakkibag Gorakhpur and has the honour of being the first Shishu Mandir of the Country. Later on it was felt that the classes should be extended upto class XII. In 1968 the school was started in the same campus for VI. In 1986, we got affiliation from CBSE for Class IX & X and in 1993 up to XII. Now the school provides education to 2200 students from Nur to XII.

The school managing committee has decided to start **Saraswati Vidya Mandir** English Medium CBSE Pattern primary classes from L.K.G. to V (Boys & Girls) from the session 2016-17 in **Phulwaria**, **Azamgarh**.

#### Fee Structure:

The dates wile be extended

1st Installment: April (Apirl + May)
2nd Installment: July (June + July)

3rd Installment : August (August + September)

 6th Installment : November (February + March)

The dates for fee collection will be  $5^{\text{th}}$  to  $20^{\text{th}}$  of each month. In case of holiday/holidays on fee dates.

#### Note:

- Fee can be deposited for the entire session with the first installment.
- 2. Along with monthly fee an Annual Fee Rs. 1000/- (once for a year) will be deposited with 1st installment.
- 3. In case of non payment of the fee within the stipulated time late fee of Rs. 50/- per installment per month will be collected in next fee payable installment month with the fee of two installment.

#### 1. Pre-Primary (L.K.G to U.K.G)

The admission in L.K.G and U.K.G classes will be on the basis of written and oral test. The test will be taken for the subjects Hindi, English, Mathematics, Rhymes and recognition of flowers, animals, colours and tools.

#### 2. Primary

The admission will be based on written test and interview. The test will be taken for the subject Hindi, English, G.K. and Mathematics. The successful students must be present with their parents.

From 7:30 am to 12:30 pm. (Primary)

From July to March - From 8:30 am to 12:30 pm. (Pre-primary)

## SchoolUniform



(For class L.K.G and U.K.G) Monday to Friday

For Summer: Royal blue half pant/skirt, Royal blue with white checks half sleeves shirt with monogram, black shoes, navy blue socks.

For Saturday: House T-shirt, white half pant/skirt white shoes, white socks.

**For Winter**: V-Neck Sweater Royal blue with white strip and monogram/Navy blue blazer, Royal blue full pant and white full pant for boys and skirt for girls, full shirt royal blue with white checks and monogram, navy blue cap or muffler or scraf for boys and girls, blue or white slacks for girls.



(For class I to V) Monday to Friday

**For Summer:** White shirt with monogram, grey (J.C.T. Fagwada shade no. 91) half pant/skirt (girls), black shoes and grey socks.
